1. Call to Order / Establishment of Quorum /Roll Call

2.1 President's Comments:

The Board discussed the status of ICON, the Paycheck Protection Program funds received, COVID operations for Ranch staff, the Pioneer Assessment and Arcadia Sissoo Trees.

- Market Street Villas roof replacement (units 46, 47 and 48) complete (reserve expense)
- Standards for Conduct were recorded (DCR 23 and 27) – available on website
- Security survey scheduled in June
- Data-bender project complete (\$650 per entry area) – 26 total (billed back sub-associations)
- Maintenance facility camera install (four cameras) - \$5,000
- Sub-Association culvert inspections complete (they are billed for Ranch work on culverts)
- Parcel 6.9 culvert cleanout project scheduled (\$10,000)
- Park and Manor Turf Reduction underway (\$3,500 square feet)
- Playground inspections finishing up (April and October – there are 14 play structures)
- Board orientation completed (4-16)
- NVM elections for Matheson's NVM position in Country Club Village underway
- Rick Spargo filled Hawkins' NVM position
- City of Scottsdale controller rebates (18 now and 26 in a couple weeks) = \$20,000 in total
